

- Scholarships We are dedicated to transforming young people's lives from all ethnic and socio economic backgrounds, most of whom would financially be unable to fund our programmes.
- Gear and safety packages, Safety is our number 1 priority. Ensuring our students are safe, relies on us keeping our operational gear in top condition. With nearly 2,000 activity days per year, we need to replace between €2,000-€5,000 of operational safety gear and equipment on an annual basis.
- Building Capacity of the company to IMPACT more lives by expanding our staff team, \$\varepsilon 5000\$ service provision and to advocate for activity based therapies
